# **Event location**

Bath is located in the South West of England about <u>90 minutes by train from London<sup>1</sup></u> and a short drive from both the M4 and M5 motorways. <u>Direct coach travel<sup>2</sup></u> is available from London Victoria Coach station and from Heathrow Airport with arrival at Bath Bus Station in the heart of the city centre.

Bristol International Airport to Bath is approximately 40 minutes by car. There is a <u>direct bus</u>  $link^3$  to Bath which takes around 75 minutes and a <u>bus and train link</u><sup>4</sup> which takes around an hour, depending on rail connection times.

The conference will take place at the University of Bath, just outside the city centre, in the <u>Chancellors' Building</u><sup>5</sup>, a modern teaching space on the east side of campus, <u>number 3 on</u> this map<sup>6</sup>.

## On foot

Delegates staying in the city centre and looking for an opportunity to incorporate some morning exercise in their programme might enjoy the walk up long hill from the city centre, it takes about 35 to 40 minutes and the views over the city and surrounding countryside are lovely.

## By taxi

It only takes about 5 minutes by taxi from the city centre to the University – request to enter the campus via Norwood Avenue and to be dropped at the Taxi rank beside the Bus terminus (sat nav BA2 7PA)

## By bus

Travel by bus from the city centre is easy and takes about 15 minutes. Bath Bus Station is located on Dorchester Street. Buses to the University stop opposite the bus station and other locations<sup>7</sup>.

## By car

If you are driving please enter the campus via Norwood Avenue off Claverton Down Road, use BA2 7PA for sat nav. Parking is available in the East Car park, use 'Permit Holder parking spaces' and display this parking permit in your car windscreen.
