Travel

Musselburgh train station is situated only a stone's throw away from the Queen Margaret University campus, with rail travel from Edinburgh Waverley Station only a short six-minute journey via the North Berwick train. Musselburgh train station is the first stop on this line, and QMU is a two-minute walk from the station. For times and tickets go to the **Scotrail** website.



As well as regular bus services to and from campus, QMU can also be accessed by car via the sliproad off the A1 southbound, between the exit for Newcraighall/Craigmillar and the Old Craighall Roundabout.
